The 2006 Boulder Race Schedule has arrived!

The best 5 of 7 of the above races will be scored for Boulder members only scoring just for our club. Three of the races for Boulder's scoring will be from the multi-club distance lake-wide races.

The Renshaw Regatta will be on August 26.

The Boulder Cup will be on October 7.

Multi-club Program:

There will be a total of 9 lake-wide distance races that combine all four clubs on the lake. Please see <u>http://www.carlyleyachtclub.com/distance.html</u> for complete details of the distance series racing and rules.

I encourage everyone to participate in all of the multi-club distance races. They will be scored as lake-wide racing results for a 9 race series. From some of these multi-club races (the ones listed above), 3 will also be scored into the 2006 Boulder Series Standings. So for some races your results will be ranked in the lake-wide results and for Boulder's own individual standings.

The multi-club race schedule is May 13, May 20, June 3, June 17, July 1, Sept. 9, Sept. 30, Oct.14, and Oct. 28 (Great Race).

I have uploaded the Race Form in the FILES Section of the Boulder Yahoo Groups Page. Please fill out and return to me as soon as possible. The fee for this year's racing is \$45. That includes all of the Boulder Series Races (including the Moonlight Regatta and Renshaw Regatta) and all of the Multi-club Races.


