**---BYC FLOTSAM & JETSAM---****Leukemia Cup Regatta news**

Mark your calendar. The Leukemia Cup Regatta launch party is coming up on Tuesday, April 13, 2010. Join us for what will be a great evening from 6:30 to 10:30 at Kemoll's Top of the Met.

Can you believe it? This is the 10th year of the Leukemia Cup Regatta at Carlyle Lake. In that time the Carlyle Regatta has raised over \$386,000 in the effort to find cures and treatments for blood cancers. Much progress has been made, but much more needs to be done.

To help us celebrate, we will have two special guests for the Launch Party. Gary Jobson, a leukemia survivor, will be here for the 3rd time. You know him as the President of the U.S. Sailing Association, ESPN's

sailing commentator and a national spokesman for our sport as well as the LCR National Chairman. He most recently hosted the America's Cup Regatta on ESPN360. You can be sure he'll be talking about the phenomenal performance of those two boats and the goings on between the contending camps.

Joining Gary is Anna Tunnicliffe, the reigning Olympic gold Medalist in the Laser Class, a member of the US Sailing Team and a 2-time Rolex Yachswoman of the Year. In addition, Anna has been the ISAF world's Number One-ranked women's Radial sailor since the April 9, 2008 rankings. If it sails, it seems she can win with it. She is now preparing for the 2012 Olympics and taking gold in the women's match racing event.

Advance reservations are \$25 per person or \$30 at the door. This includes hors d'oeuvres and an open bar. Kemoll's is at the Metropolitan Square Bldg, 211 North Broadway, 42nd Floor, St. Louis, MO. (free parking available from the Pine Street Kemoll's Restaurant entrance.)
