# ---BYC FLOTSAM & JETSAM---

Last weekend some ventured to the Strictly Sail Show in Chicago. I have been to quite a few in the past and this is the first time I didn't see ice at the Navy Pier. Most people go by train as parking cars is expensive in Chicago but we found a Hotel that has free parking so we drove.

To compare with years past I think less large boats, more small boats, less venders and less people. The smaller crowds made it easier to board the boats get to the venders, and the beer in the snack area. Our group (me, Sharon, and Schmidty) boarded some small boats. We talked to venders. You can get information straight from the manufacturer rather than some dealer that may or may not know very much.

While in Chicago you might as well see some of the nightlife and being with Schmidty we went to a night spot featuring blues music. Close to the hotel there was true blues music with an international crowd. Word must get around about Blues Chicago.

**Getting a jump on spring.** Sometimes, it's the little things that get overlooked; something as minor as a worn impeller or dead battery can ruin a day on the water. Even major things like a dismasting from a cracked fitting or a ruined engine due to clogged manifolds can be prevented by a quick inspection. This winter, devote some time to a few easy inspections or simple projects to make sure next spring your boat is ready for smooth (and safe) sailing. Check your motors impeller. A worn impeller could make the difference the

embarrassment of being towed in or landing on the rocks. Check your stuffing box this could make the difference of a leaking boat when launching your boat. Check for worn hoses and seacocks that could also cause leaks. Check your steering linkage this could also keep you out of unwanted places. Check your batteries as this may keep you from wanted places. Some other things to check are batteries, engine fluids, standing rigging, running rigging, winches, and for us trailerable boats check that trailer before you move that boat. These are just some of the things to check to make the upcoming boating season a pleasant. We sometimes forget these in the winter and get in a hurry in the spring.
