----FROM THE RACE CHAIR ----

As I said its mandatory to race this year. Sorry no excuses!

New this year is that we will make the races very easy and safe for everybody. Hound and Hare and simple courses will dominate this season. Also we will participate in some lake wide races to earn points for our own

Championship. This is fun and absolute necessary to keep all our race programs alive around the lake. We want the other guys come to our races, we can't expect them to come when we don't participate in their races!

Championship rules: Participate in at least 3 races throughout the year and you qualify. We have 7 races planned, but only 5 will count towards the year end points.

If you do CB than your boat will earn a 2nd place finish. No CB duty more than 2 times as we will rotate within the participants. We will meet at 9 am at the Clubhouse and determine who is doing CB for that race. Let's say you participated in 3 races we will add points to your total at the end of the year for 5 races. The 2 races you did not start in will get points for last place plus 2. The lowest accumulated points win. For the lake wide races we only count BYC members for our Championship.

If you have any rules questions, yes there is a book with hundreds of sometimes difficult to understand rules. Basically it's like this however:

Starboard over Port

Leeward over Windward

If you are unsure keep distance or even tack away.....even if you are correct it's not worth an accident. You can protest the other boat after the race (and you should)

It's really that simple. Rules are necessary but the most important part is having fun.

Back in the program is the Renshaw...... Mr. Renshaw was one of the founding members of BYC and started a race program some 40 years ago. Keep the long weekend in September open to join us keeping history alive.
