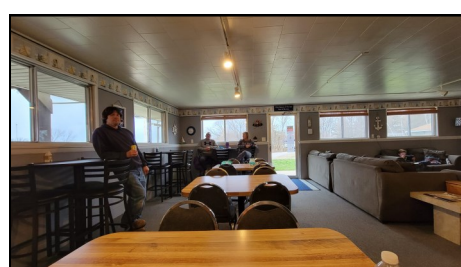
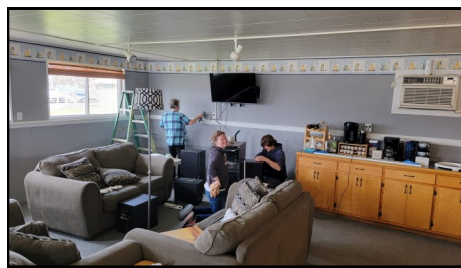
Also, don't forget to check the Events Board in the Marina building. Events are also posted on our website and you can watch our Facebook page for updates. I hope to see you all soon.
