Ahoy fellow sailors,

In June we had one race, which was really two. We combined our Intro to Racing Session 2 with the lake wide Cruiser's Cup. It' wasn't very well attended mostly due to the forecast of 1-2 mph winds. Most races need at least 5 mph of wind to start. Miss Scarlett and Paradise were the only 2 entrants from BYC. CYC had 3 boats, but 2 of them were in another fleet that would not be counted in the Cruiser's Cup. TYC had no entrants.

As the meeting on the water was at 11:00, both Miss Scarlett and Paradise headed down to the start line. Miss Scarlett was heading down there, they hailed CYC committee boat to see what was happening and if there would still be a race as the wind was so low. They said they were going to anchor and swim! That was not a good sign. But as Paradise had 2 sea scouts as crew, they decided to still head down to the start. The crew of Paradise still had a lot of fun however!

Miss Scarlett made up some time on the way back to Cole's Creek which put them in first place for our BYC race. Martha J from CYC crossed the finish line first however. Results are not in from CYC yet to know final results. BUT it's not over as there is a second Cruiser's Cup on August 26, so let's try for more boats from BYC!
